CHORAL COMPETITION

The jury of competition includes famous choral experts from around the world. The result and scores will be decided by the total amount of jury evaluations. (No objections will be accepted regarding the result.)

COMPETITION CATEGORY

Participating more than 2 categories is available but performing the same repertoire for different categories is prohibited.

- **A. SACRED** -This category includes all sacred music from the Renaissance to Contemporary choral music. There are no limitation lyrics(language). The actual performance and the submitted score must be identical even if it is arranged. There are no limits on using accompanying instrument, however, MR/AR is not allowed, ONLY LIVE PERFORMANCE. The performance must be 10 minutes and 2 pieces maximum.
- **B. FOLKLORE** -From this category, the participant may choose any folklore choral piece. The lyrics does not have to be in the original language but must contain folk melody and lyrics. Traditional choreography or costume may add additional points. There are no limits on using accompanying instrument, however, MR/AR is not allowed, ONLY LIVE PERFORMANCE. The performance must be 10 minutes and 2 pieces maximum.
- **C. SECULAR** -Any choral piece including A cappella and contemporary which does not belong in A or B can be performed in this category. There are no limits on using accompanying instrument, however, MR/AR is not allowed, ONLY LIVE PERFORMANCE. The performance must be 10 minutes and 2 pieces maximum.
- *GRAND PRIX -The choirs who earn the highest score from each category will be qualified to compete for the Grand prix. Even though the choir receives the highest score from a category, the score must exceed the minimum to qualify for the Grand prix round.

^{*}Other articles which choirs may consider for the competition:

- Did the choir select a suitable piece for themselves and category?
- Was the duration of the performance over the time limit?
- Was the choreography suitable with the music? etc.

COMMON REGULATION

- 1. Copyrights regarding music scores and any other information materials submitted to the festival committee by the choir will not be the committee's responsibility, but the participants will be liable.
- 2. Competition will be opened only to the participants who registered, however, those who are willing to walk-in on that day without registration will not be able to enter the venue.
- 3. Each piece (music score) must be submitted by one PDF file. The music score and the performance must be identical (if the score has been arranged, the final score file must be arrange as it is performed), and a brief program note for each song must be submitted in English with the score.
- 4. Festival participants(singers) must be 18 or under (who was born on July 16th, 2007 or after).
 - *Please keep age limit.
- 5. Submitting the materials after the deadline may bring disadvantage to the evaluation.
- 6. Category winner team must earn the highest score and Gold medal from their participating category. If the choir earns the highest score with a silver medal, they will not be qualified as winner of category.
- 7. Each category winner must earn the minimum score to be qualified for Grand Prix finalists.
- 8. Competition duration time per category will be maximum 10 minutes with 2 songs.



^{*} Lower than 70.0 is not qualified for medals

9. There will be no limits using any accompanying instruments, and choir must perform LIVE.(using MR/AR are not acceptable)

-Certificate & Trophy will be given according to the choir's performances (including competing and non-competing stages during the festival).
